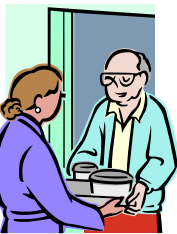

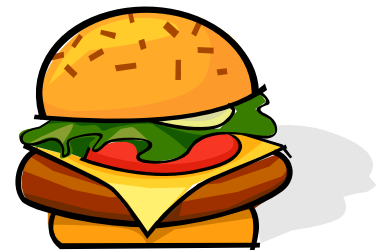

# MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

**Parkway Family Fund** – money designated for this fund is used to specifically help Parkway families who may be experiencing a temporary crisis.

**African Pastor Training Fund** – Parkway has planted the seed of Pastor Training in Africa under the leadership of Robert Kamau several years ago. Now hundreds of pastors are in place due to the generous financial support of the Parkway Family. Our goal is to help train pastors to help transform Africa one life at a time.

**Street Ministry** – you can volunteer to go with our street ministry team each Wednesday night to various mission points in Jackson. You might want to lead your Sunday School class to volunteer to make sandwiches one Wednesday night a month.

**Street Ministry Clothes** – check your closet and find some summer clothes items, (children, women or men) to donate to our street ministry. These clothes are distributed by our street ministry team on Wednesday evenings.

**African Mission Fund** – You might like to give to help with the mission ministry of Chandas, Ndumus, Kamaus, and Njuguna families in Kenya and Zambia. You can give to the African Mission Fund, or designate your gift to any of the four families.

**Feed A Child in Kenya** – you might like to give to this ministry the Ndumu's initiated in Kenya. Kenya has been severely impacted by famine and children are dying because of malnutrition. Every penny you give to this ministry project goes directly to help feed children.

**Lighthouse School** – A Christian school initiated in Zambia led by Zicky Chanda

**Tracepointe Sunday Afternoon Devotional** – Gayle Garrett needs some volunteers who are willing every other month to go to Tracepointe Retirement Center here in Clinton to play the piano, sing, visit the residents or share a brief devotional.

**Buried Treasures Home for Women** – our current project involves collecting paper goods such as paper towels and toilet paper for this ministry. Other information will be shared in upcoming editions of the Heartbeat

**Habitat for Humanity** – Parkway provides financial support and volunteers. A new Habitat House project for Clinton is now in the planning stage.

**Gleaners Ministry** - this ministry experience involves being actively on your feet for about 2 1/2 to 3 hours per time. You sort and maybe weigh donated food and put it up for storage or put in baskets to be picked up that day--no sitting around drinking coffee and talking! There's nothing hard about it--no heaving lifting or anything. You can also be a truck driver going around to pick up the donated food.

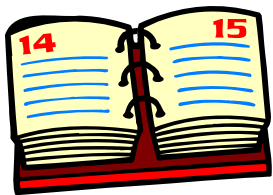
